Find the Squares Oppositions and Conjunctions to the Personal Planets, Sun, Moon, Mercury, Venus, and Mars from the Outer Planets (highlighted in dark grey) Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune, Pluto and Chiron. You can also note the outer planet relationships to one another but those are generational and NOT personal aspects.

Be sure to only count aspects once. For example if you have Saturn Square the Sun only enter it in the section where the Sun is located. This means you would NOT include it in the section where Saturn is. If you have Saturn conjunct Neptune then you only enter it once in that section. Otherwise you will wind up counting these complexes twice.

The primary emphasis of the Outer Planets to the Angles or Nodes are when they are **conjunct** though the squares can have an effect, they usually aren't as powerful as the conjunctions to the angles or Nodes. When an Outer Planet is conjunct an Angle or Node it is automatically opposite the Angle or Node.
