***Planetary Aspects** – Transits apply only when nodes or outer planets (Jupiter, Saturn, Chiron, Uranus, Neptune, Pluto) aspect personal planets: Moon, Nodes, Sun, Venus, Mercury, Vesta, Mars and Jupiter

****Jupiter and Saturn personal transits' orb are occasionally different that just "1 degree"**

depending on the closest pass of Jupiter or Saturn during its retrograde loop. This is because sometimes Jupiter or Saturn will transit a *target degree* only once.
