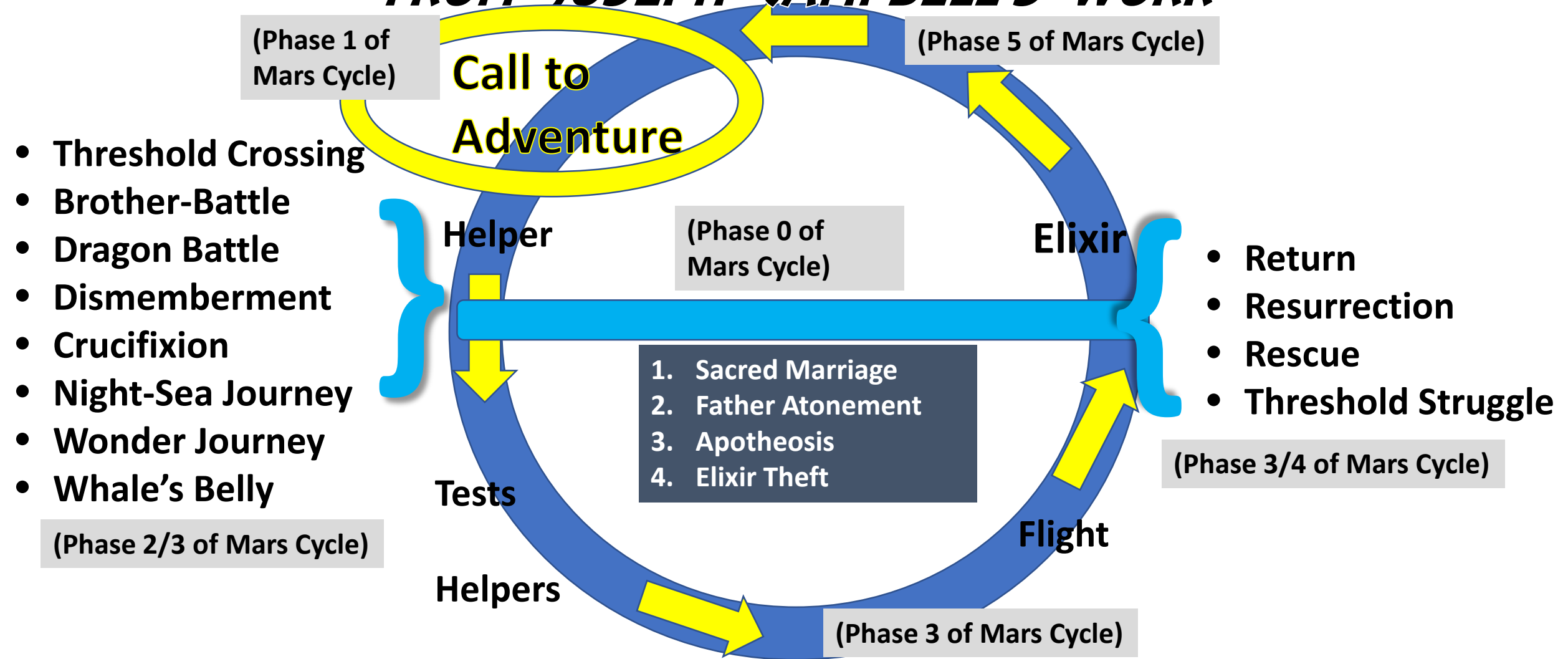


How the Mars Synodic Cycle Resonates or Correlates with the “Hero’s Journey”

- In countless myths and stories throughout the globe, the Hero’s Journey or Quest is told in infinite ways
 - There is a signal or sign to begin the adventure (Phase 1)
 - There are a number of challenges the hero undertakes (Phase 2)
 - There is a period of “defeat” or “surrender” to themselves and their shadow (Phase 3)
 - There is a Rebirthing or Resurrection; The hero grows in maturity and is ready to take on whatever comes next (Phase 4)
 - The hero becomes highly experienced, enters An Elder stage and must take on a final mission or adventure (Phase 5)
 - The Hero’s Journey comes to an end with a final song; legacy, immortality and eventual rest are the chief concerns during this phase (Phase Zero)
- The Breakdown of the 6 Phases of the Mars Synodic Cycle (developed by Daniel Giamario) correlates loosely with what Joseph Campbell calls the “Monomyth”
